Logging into Your Class

1. Launch a web browser. Canvas works best with Firefox.
2. Go to the [eLearning page](#) of Whatcom's web site and click the Canvas Login button.
3. On the login page, enter your student ID number as the username and the first six letters of your last name (all lower case) as the password.
4. If your name is shorter than six letters, repeat it until you reach six letters, e.g., doedoe.
5. If you have more than one Canvas course, click the “Courses” tab at the top of the screen to select the class you want to open.

If you're having any technical problems, or if there's something you can't figure out how to do in your online class, hit Reply for assistance from the Student Help Desk!

Your Student Network Account

It's true that you can complete your online course from home without a student network account. But your WCC student network account will allow you to log into WCC campus computers and the campus wireless network. You can use it from home (after you download **VMware**) to get remote access to campus computer resources. It also gives you access to your student account at **MS Outlook Live**, which provides you with a WCC student email account.

Setting up your WCC Student Network Account

1. Launch Firefox (or another browser). Go to <https://mywcc.whatcom.edu>.
2. Click on Recover Password (top right hand corner of your browser window).
3. On the Recover Password page you'll need to enter the following information **exactly** as it appears on your registration paperwork:
 - **Student ID Number** (ex. SID-870123456): Your SID# is assigned when you first enroll at WCC.
 - **First Name**: Enter your first name as shown on your schedule for the

quarter.

- **Last Name:** Enter your last name as shown on your schedule. The last name field doesn't accept spaces. For example, Van Heusen won't work.
- **Birth Date:** Enter your 8 digit birthdate with slashes, e.g., 01/12/1984.
- **Student PIN:** Your student PIN is your 6 digit birthdate without slashes, e.g., 011284 (unless you've already changed it via OASIS).
- **Last year attended:** This refers to the most recent quarter you've enrolled in. You're currently enrolled in Spring Quarter 2014, so enter **2014** as the last year attended.

4. Make up a password. *Your password must meet the following requirements:*

- It must be a **minimum of 8** characters but **no more than 16** characters in length.
- It must contain **only letters and numbers**. Spaces and symbols aren't allowed.
- It must include at least **1 number**.
- It must include at least **1 uppercase letter**.
- It must include at least **1 lowercase letter**.
- The password **must not contain your first name, last name, or SID**.

Accessing your student email account

1. Launch Firefox (or another browser). Go to <https://live.com>.
2. Use your WCC student email address (e.g., YourWCCUsername1234@student.whatcom.edu) in the Windows Live ID field and the password you chose when you set up your WCC student network account.
